



## MD 24 Interchange Project Progress Notification

Dear Resident:

The Maryland Transportation Authority (MDTA) is making great progress on the I-95 Express Toll Lanes (ETL) Northbound Extension/MD 24 Interchange Reconstruction Project and is providing this update to keep you informed of construction activities in your area.

Reconfiguration of the MD 24 interchange to accommodate the future northbound I-95 ETL requires changes to existing traffic patterns that include removal, relocation, or addition of ramps resulting in new ways drivers will access I-95, MD 24 and MD 924.

The MDTA anticipates construction of the first ramp of the reconfigured interchange will be completed by the end of summer. The new ramp from southbound I-95 to northbound MD 924 will follow a similar alignment to the existing ramp but be shifted to the north approximately 200 feet. (See map below.)

While the MDTA makes every attempt to minimize disruptions and inconvenience to its customers with safety in mind, there will be impacts to motorists and residents. You may notice the following activities or equipment in your area:

- Utility relocation
- Fence removal or relocation
- Earthmovers
- Bulldozers
- Day or night work
- Milling / Grinding machines
- Paving / Resurfacing
- Back-up alarms
