The Maryland Transportation Authority (MDTA) is proposing to continue staged implementation of the I-95 Section 200 approved NEPA FONSI improvements. Phase I has already been authorized and is under construction. Phase II of the Section 200 program will include Express Toll Lane extensions on northbound I-95, safety and operational improvements along northbound I-95, installation of noise walls, construction of Park and Ride facilities, installation of an ITS communication system for improved operations and incident management, and impacts. Some of the proposed improvements may result in temporary and permanent impacts to nontidal wetlands and waterways. As such, MDTA is submitting an application to the Maryland Department of the Environment to obtain authorization for this work. Due to the overall size of the project, preliminary plans are not being provided with this notification; however, they can be reviewed upon request.
