

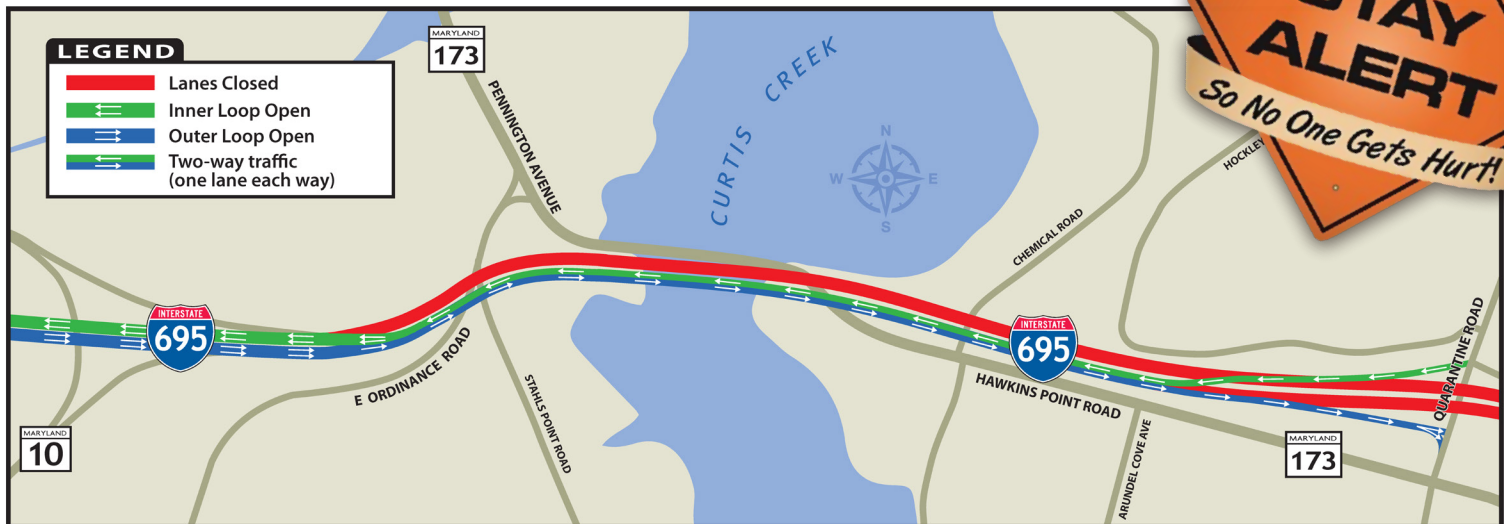

Project Update!

New Traffic Pattern – August 2026

- Beginning August 19, weather permitting, the Inner Loop of I-695 will be closed between Quarantine Road (Exit 1) and MD 10 (Exit 2).
- Two-way traffic will operate on the Outer Loop I-695 (one lane in each direction).
- Truck restrictions: No over-sized loads will be permitted between Exit 1 (Quarantine Road) and Exit 2 (MD 10) until the project is completed.
