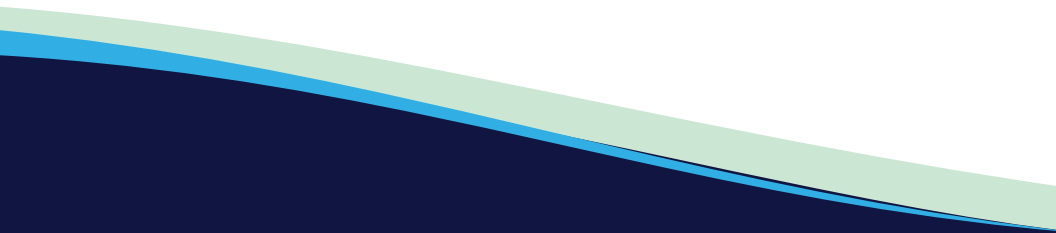

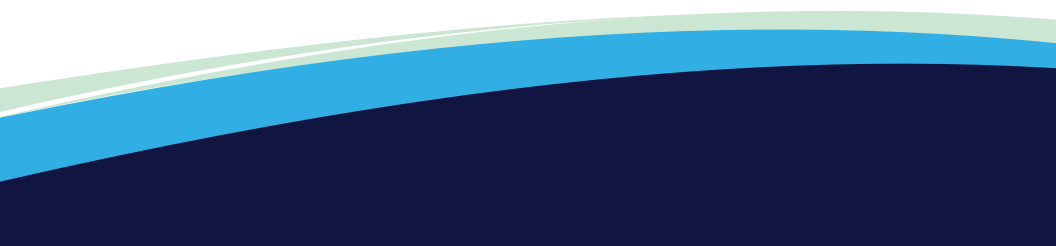
About the I-95 ETL Northbound Extension

This project will enhance the MDTA's efforts to provide a safe and reliable drive for its customers and expands the Traffic Relief Plan that Governor Larry Hogan announced in December 2017. In addition, the proposed improvements will increase quality of life for numerous communities with the addition of five new noise walls and will replace or rehabilitate multiple bridges that are more than 50 years old. The extension is expected to be open to traffic in June 2023 through MD 152 and in 2026 through MD 24.

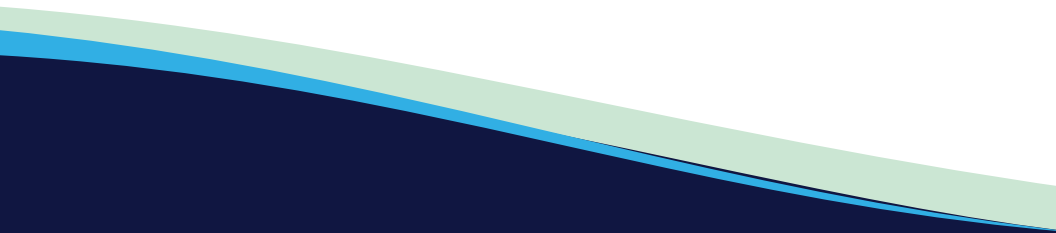
