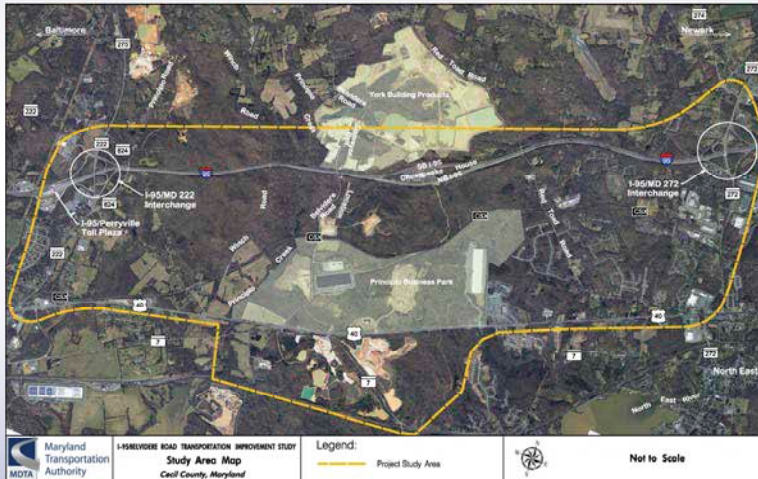


# I-95 at BELVIDERE ROAD

## TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROJECT



You are invited to view the ***Spring 2020 Virtual Project Update***



The Maryland Transportation Authority (MDTA), in coordination with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and Cecil County, is proposing a new interchange along I-95 at Belvidere Road. This interchange would accommodate future traffic capacity and safety needs due to current and planned development within the Principio Enterprise Zone in Cecil County. The proposed improvements are Cecil County's top transportation and economic priority and would be completed as a Public Private Partnership (P3) between MDTA, Cecil County, and Stewart Properties. Due to the COVID-19 state of emergency and the MDTA's commitment to the protection of our customers and team members, we are practicing social distancing by making the project update available online. The ***spring 2020 virtual project update*** consists of a recorded closed-captioned video posted on the project website and will present the selected alternative, the evaluation process, and the project schedule moving forward.
