Due to the COVID-19 state of emergency and the Maryland Transportation Authority's (MDTA) commitment to the protection of our customers and team members, we are practicing social distancing by holding a virtual project update for the I-95 at Belvidere Road Transportation Improvements. The MDTA, in coordination with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and Cecil County, is studying the roadway network in the vicinity of Belvidere Road to accommodate future traffic capacity and safety needs due to current and planned development within the Principio Enterprise Zone in Cecil County. The proposed improvements are Cecil County's top transportation and economic priority and would be completed as a Public Private Partnership (P3) between MDTA, Cecil County, and Stewart Properties. The spring 2020 virtual project update will consist of a recorded close-captioned video presentation posted to the project website. Information presented in this project update will include:

- The interchange alternative selected for the project
- An overview of our evaluation criteria for selecting the interchange alternative
- The project schedule moving forward
