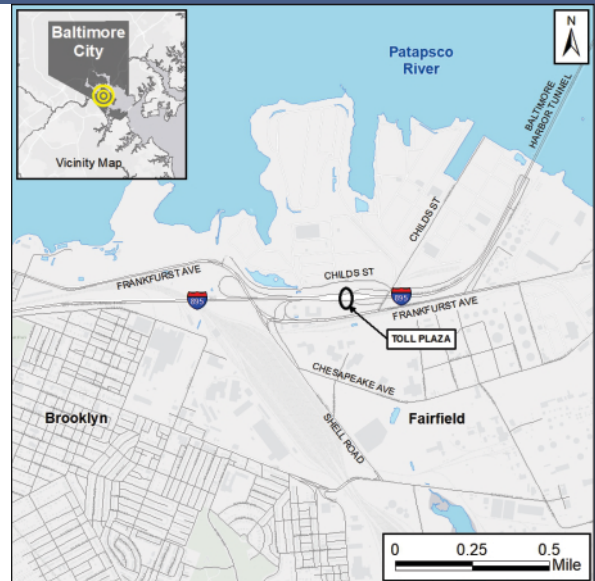

The I-895/Baltimore Harbor Tunnel Toll Plaza and Interchange Improvements Project in Baltimore is proposed to replace the existing toll booths across I-895 with overhead gantries to allow for electronic toll collection at highway speeds. The project will improve capacity, travel times, safety, customer convenience, and the potential for long-term reduction in toll collection and maintenance costs while reducing emissions. The project includes changes to the I-895 interchange ramps at both Frankfurst Avenue and Childs Street.

Recognizing the COVID-19 state of emergency and the Maryland Transportation Authority's (MDTA) commitment to the protection of our customers and team members, we are practicing social distancing by holding a Virtual Public Meeting for the I-895/Baltimore Harbor Tunnel Toll Plaza and Interchange Improvements Project.
