



# MAJOR ROADWORK I-695 ON CURTIS CREEK DRAWBRIDGE EXPECT DELAYS

Changing traffic patterns starting July 2018 through November 2018  
between Quarantine Rd. (Exit 1) and MD 10 (Exit 2).

The Maryland Transportation Authority (MDTA) will begin the second phase of the rehabilitation of the Curtis Creek Drawbridge, located south of the Francis Scott Key Bridge on I-695. This preservation project, funded completely by toll revenue, is part of the MDTA's commitment to preserving and maintaining the State's aging toll bridges, tunnels and highways.

## Nighttime Closures of I-695 (both directions)

Friday, July 13 through Sunday, July 15 from 8 p.m. – 6 a.m.  
I-695 closed between Quarantine Rd. (Exit 1) and MD 10 (Exit 2)

**Inner Loop I-695 Detour:** Inner Loop I-695 to Quarantine Rd., to Pennington Ave., to Ordnance Rd., to northbound MD 10, to Inner Loop I-695

**Outer Loop I-695 Detour:** Outer Loop I-695 to southbound MD 10, to Ordnance Rd., to Pennington Ave., to Hawkins Point Rd., to Ft. Armistead Rd., to Outer Loop I-695

## 24/7 Closure of Northbound MD 10 On-ramp to Outer Loop I-695

Friday, July 13 through November 2018  
Ramp from northbound MD 10 to Outerloop I-695 closed 24/7

**Ramp from northbound MD 10 Detour:** Ordnance Rd., to Pennington Ave., to Hawkins Point Rd., to Ft. Armistead Rd., to Outer Loop I-695

## 24/7 One Lane Closure of Inner Loop I-695

Friday, July 13 through November 2018  
Inner Loop I-695 reduced to one lane between Quarantine Rd. (Exit 1) and MD 10 (Exit 2)

## 24/7 Closure of Outer Loop I-695

Monday, July 16 through November 2018  
Outer Loop I-695 closed between MD 10 (Exit 2) and Quarantine Rd. (Exit 1) 24/7  
Two-way traffic will operate on the Inner Loop I-695 (one lane open in each direction)
