

CLOSURES/TRAFFIC PATTERN CHANGES ON I-695 AT SPARROWS POINT NEAR BEAR CREEK



Project Update!

New Traffic Pattern - December 2024

- Beginning December 12, weather permitting, the I-695 Inner Loop and ramp to Exit 43 will reopen. The Inner Loop will carry one lane of traffic through the I-695 Sparrows Point project work zone. Exit 44 to Broening Highway is the last exit on the I-695 Inner Loop.
- A portion of the southeast I-695 Outer Loop remains closed beginning at Exit 43.
- I-695 Outer Loop through traffic must exit onto MD 158/Bethlehem Boulevard and return to the Outer Loop at the Bethlehem Boulevard on-ramp.
- Access to I-695 Outer Loop from Broening Highway remains open via existing turnaround; there is no stopping or parking along the loop road.
