The Maryland Transportation Authority (MDTA) is holding an Informational Open House for the I-895 at Frankfurst Avenue Interchange Improvements Project and the proposed closures of railroad crossings in and around Old Pennington Avenue and Vera Street. This project will complete MDTA's conversion of toll plazas to highway speed all-electronic tolling, reconfigure the access points to I-895, and replace/rehabilitate the aging infrastructure.

The proposed improvements will enhance safety for motorists, foster economic growth, reduce congestion and emission-related pollution and bring MDTA assets into a state of good repair.

Informational Open House attendees will be able to:

- learn about the project and its benefits for commuters and local communities,
- learn about the construction phases and timeline,
- learn about traffic impacts during construction,
- learn about the proposed railroad crossing* closures associated with the project, and
- sign up for project alerts.
