I-95 AT BELVIDERE ROAD | TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT STUDY



INFORMATIONAL PUBLIC OPEN HOUSE

The Maryland Transportation Authority (MDTA) in coordination with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) is studying the roadway network in the vicinity of Belvidere Road to accommodate future traffic capacity and safety needs at the Interstate I-95 (I-95)/MD 222 interchange, US 40, MD 222 and MD 272 due to planned development in the area. Alternatives will be presented ranging from a No-Build or No-Action Alternative to a Transportation System Management (TSM) Alternative and four different interchange options.

For additional information, you are invited to attend an Informational Public Open House on Thursday, January 17, from 5 - 8 p.m. (Snow date January 24*). The meeting is being held in accordance with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) to inform the public of:

- The Purpose and Need
- Range of Alternatives

- Existing environmental conditions
- Responses to comments from July 2018 meeting

Comments are encouraged from attendees to help inform the NEPA study and obtain feedback on the potential transportation solutions. The open house also provides an opportunity for public comment regarding historic properties consistent with Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act. Maps and displays will be available for review. MDTA representatives will be available to answer study-related questions and to receive public comments. There will be no formal presentation. You may arrive at any time during the meeting hours and walk through the display area at your own pace.


