
No Closures Will Occur on the Same Dates as Baltimore Oriole Home Games

Weather permitting, the ramp from southbound I-95 to southbound MD 295 (Exit 52) will be temporarily closed starting Friday, April 8, at 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. Monday, April 11, and continuing weekends into Summer 2022. Closures will not occur on dates when the Baltimore Orioles have home games. In addition, when the ramp from southbound I-95 to southbound MD 295 is closed, the ramp from Hanover Street to southbound I-95 must also be closed during the same time frames.

Note: During the weekend closures, the ramps will be closed the Thursday prior from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. the following morning.



The detour for the ramp from Hanover Street to southbound I-95 will direct vehicles to turn right onto E. McComas Street, to E. McComas Street on-ramp to southbound I-95.



Additional closures may be required to complete this work. MDTA will issue additional traffic alerts when dates are determined.
