Ongoing Work Results in Temporary Closure of Ramp from Southbound I-395 to Southbound I-95 in Baltimore City

Weather permitting, the Maryland Transportation Authority (MDTA) will temporarily close the ramp from southbound I-395 to southbound I-95 on **Friday, November 4 at 10 PM, until Monday, November 7, at 5 AM**. The detour will direct motorists to E McComas St. around to the McComas Street on-ramp to southbound I-95.

Toll Dollars At Work: This closure is part of the MDTA's deck rehabilitation and joint modifications project on eight bridges located on I-95 in Baltimore City.

Detour Route for Southbound I-395 leaving the city onto Southbound I-95

Vehicles take the Southbound I-395 off-ramp to Northbound I-95, exit onto McComas Street, then use the McComas Street on-ramp to Southbound I-95. This detour will not be in place when the McComas Street on-ramp to Southbound I-95 is closed.
